The Youth Coordinator is responsible for the organization and development of programs, events and services including but not limited to Preschool, Day Camp, and Youth Specialty programs. The ideal candidate for this position will have strong skills related to creativity, customer service, communication, program management, organization and interpersonal skills.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Duties and responsibilities include but are not limited to planning, customer service, public relations, safety & risk management, personnel and financial management. As needed, this position may require driving vehicles such as a 14-passenger minibus. Specific to Preschool: responsible for scheduling staff, handling day-to-day operations, planning, organizing, conducting and evaluating all preschool special events, responsible for assisting with curriculum development, registration, plan/direct meetings, and evaluation exercises, and perform other duties as assigned. Specific to the summer camp program: responsible for camp planning and development, registration, program evaluation, handling day-to-day operations, training, scheduling, and supervising/managing all staff. Perform other duties as assigned.
