JOB SUMMARY

Under the direction and supervision of the Superintendent of Athletics, the Athletics Supervisor will be responsible for the planning and general administration of various athletics programs including recreational and travel soccer, Cyclones Volleyball, Field Hockey, and Running Club. This position will also coordinate and oversee the Turkey Trot Run and assist with summer sports camps. Responsibilities include staffing, to include volunteer coaches, scheduling, customer service, budgeting, organizing, publicizing, and safety of all assigned program areas, tournaments, and other services to promote athletics to members and the community. Other duties include but are not limited to: updating brochure (or equivalent), public relations/marketing, staff training, performance management, program instruction, inventory tracking and purchasing, and other duties as assigned.
