# **Description:**

Working Hours: The Graphic Designer is a part time non- exempt position working varied hours remotely.

Summary: The Graphic Designer is responsible for design work of all Park District communication and marketing materials.

Qualifications: A minimum of 2 years of experience in graphic design, with Park District experience preferred. Computer experience in Adobe Creative Cloud, Google Suite, Constant Contact, Calameo, and website content management.

Immediate Supervisor: The Graphic Designer reports to the Executive Director and Director of Recreation.

#### **Essential Functions:**

- 1. Communicate with the Executive Director regularly on Park District matters.
- 2. Develop 4 seasonal program guides.
- 3. Develop and update program flyers, forms, and promotional pieces.
- 4. Oversee the "Branding" of the Park District, including design and use of logos.
- 5. Perform any duties as assigned by the Executive Director.
