Additionally, the role involves developing and executing district events such as Holiday in the Hart, Trick-or-Treat Trail, and the Egg Scramble.

Recreation Supervisor performs duties with minimal supervision and must have the ability to work independently and under the general direction of the Superintendent of Recreation. Recreation Supervisor must exhibit professionalism while performing daily activities. Evening and weekend hours may be required.

- · Leads or assists with evening and weekend programs as needed.
- Oversees revenue and registration reports.
- Prepares, implements and monitors budget for assigned areas of the recreation services division.

- Prepares monthly reports for supervisor.
- Oversees purchase of supplies and equipment for programs.
- Attend appropriate meetings as assigned by the Superintendent of Recreation
- Perform all tasks within the rules and guidelines of the district's safety and operational codes and programs.
