- Provides leadership in managing and overseeing parks and recreation activities, including golf, recreation, parks, forestry, and ReLeaf programs, ensuring accessibility and inclusivity for all community members.
- Guides the development and implementation of programs and policies that support the City's mission and community needs.
- Leads the preparation and management of a large annual budget, including coordinating operating and capital improvement budgets, conducting budget analysis, making data-informed financial decisions, and researching grant funding opportunities; develops fee structures.
- Supervises and directs the work of assigned personnel.
- Collaborates with the Director Team to develop and assess programs and policies.
- Participates on various boards, committees, and task force teams.
- Evaluates policies and makes recommendations to enhance the accessibility, sustainability, and effectiveness of Parks and Recreation programs.
- Maintains the department's CAPRA accreditation status.
- Oversees cost estimation, project design, specification development, bid solicitation, project management, and contract administration with a focus on transparency and community benefit.
- Represents the City and fosters effective communication across many community sectors
