- 4. Repair and rebuild fleet vehicles and equipment for park operations as required.
- 5. Maintain reel and rotary mowers to industry standards.
- 6. Clean and maintain the shop, equipment, and tools.
- 7. Document repair and preventative maintenance records for all fleet equipment.
- 8. Follow all Federal, State, District, and departmental safety and risk management policies, procedures, ordinances and regulations.
- 9. Report all accidents, incidents, and unsafe conditions in a timely manner.
- 10. Additional job duties as assigned, which may be considered essential.

Minimum Requirements

- Graduate from vocational school supplemented by an approved apprenticeship or training in mechanical repair
- A.S.E. certification preferred or acquired within two (2) years of employment
- Minimum of five (5) or more years of demonstrated success as a mechanic or any equivalent combination of education, experience, and training
- Must provide own tools
