- Creates and implements marketing of all Teen Center activities, including a quarterly newsletter, and maintains the Teen Center webpage and social media.
- Conducts youth recruitment and outreach, specifically to area schools.

Qualified candidates should...

- Have a Bachelor's Degree in recreation, education, social work, or a related field. Master's Degree preferred.
- Have a minimum of three (3) years of work experience with adolescents in a related or similar environment.
- Have the ability to complete DCFS training and serve as a mandated reporter.
- Have supervisory experience (preferred).
- Be proficient in Microsoft Office products and other design platforms such as Canva.
- Have excellent listening, verbal, and written communication skills.
- Have a valid State of Illinois Driver's License and be able to drive a Village vehicle.
- Be able to occasionally lift and/or move objects up to 25 pounds.

- Be able to successfully complete an extensive background check.
