ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Under supervision of Athletic Maintenance Crew Leader, maintains athletic fields and courts.
- Assists in the upkeep of park district equipment and tools.
- Assists and leads in the training of full and part-time staff when required.
- Inspects and performs preventative maintenance and repairs.
- Operates trucks and special equipment as required after receiving and passing district training on vehicles/equipment.
- Performs the job safely and in compliance with district policies, procedures, work and safety rules.
- Be familiar with the safe operation of any equipment necessary in accomplishing required tasks.

- Knowledge of baseball, softball, soccer and football field set up and maintenance along with turf maintenance, irrigation, and field lighting.
